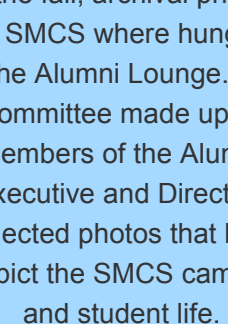
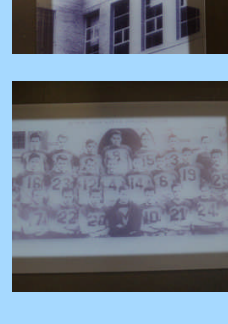

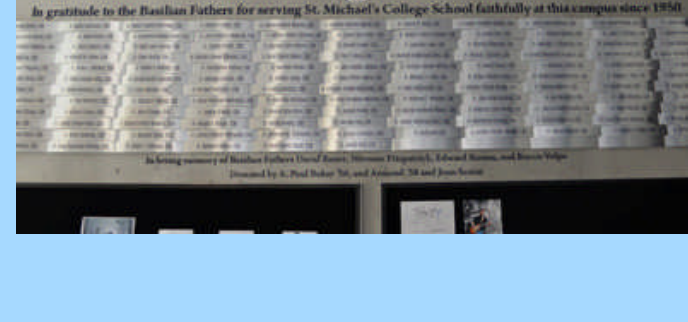

Basilian Fathers Honoured with Commemorative Wall

With special thanks to A. Paul Baker '56, and Armand '58 and Joan Scaini, a commemorative wall located in the Centre for the Arts lobby has been dedicated in loving memory of Frs. David Bauer, CSB '44, Norman Fitzpatrick, CSB, Edward Ronan, CSB '41, and Rocco Volpe, CSB '48. Both Paul and Armand wanted to recognize the Basilian Fathers for their contribution to their spiritual and educational growth. The project began modestly but grew to recognize every Basilian Father who has taught at the school's Bathurst Street campus since it opened in 1950. The wall honours all the Basilian priests who have been instrumental in shaping the lives of the young men of St. Michael's. With its location on the former site of Soulerin House, the Basilian Fathers residence, the wall bridges the history of the Basilian Fathers to future generations of students and staff of St. Michael's College School. 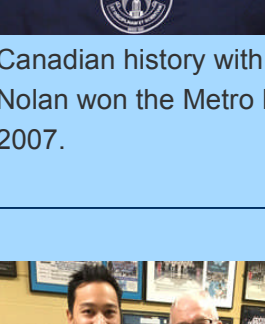

At both universities, Fr. Jeff and Greg were joined by 25 St. Mike's alumni for a reception.

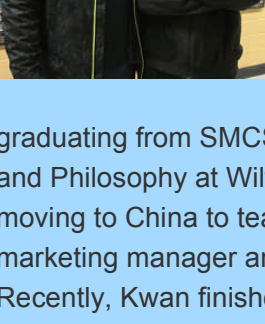
Alumni Updates
